ACT SAFELY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Use playground and classroom equipment appropriately ▪ Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself at all times ▪ Follow school rules and routines ▪ Think about possible consequences of your actions before you act ▪ Solve problems without aggression ▪ Keep mobile phones at school office during the day and collect at home time 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Walk inside buildings ▪ Keep all chair legs on the floor ▪ Enter and exit rooms in an orderly manner ▪ Ask permission to leave the classroom 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Play in the right area ▪ Participate only in school approved games – no rough play ▪ Play safely by not climbing or pulling on trees ▪ Wear shoes and socks at all times ▪ Wear a sun safe hat ▪ Run only on grassy areas away from concrete and buildings ▪ Be an active bystander by speaking up to the bully about their inappropriate behaviour ▪ Decide on the rules for games and play by them ▪ Take turns 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Walk inside toilet areas ▪ Only one person in one cubicle – no more ▪ Use toilet areas appropriately – not as a play area ▪ Wash hands 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Only use your own bike/scooter/skateboard ▪ Walk bikes, carry scooters and skateboards when on school grounds. ▪ Leave skateboards with class teacher during the day ▪ Wait inside the fence for parents ▪ Cross the road only at supervised crossings ▪ Leave school grounds promptly at home time ▪ Always follow the Code of Behaviour for Bus Travel
